**K**ids Cause is a non-profit organization in Utah County public schools which works to ensure that all students are successful by meeting their physical, emotional, and social needs.

- ✓ Kids Cause currently serves 70 schools in the Alpine School District, 40 schools in the Nebo School District and 26 schools in the Provo School District.
- ✓ Clothing, school supplies, eyeglasses, dental care, hearing aids and other needs are provided to public school students who have needs and are identified by their teachers.
- ✓ Educators who belong to NEA, UEA, and Utah County local school affiliates sponsor Kids Cause.
- ✓ Students who need medical or dental care are taken to local hospitals, doctors and dentists who donate time and services.
- ✓ All donations to Kids Cause are fully tax deductible. One hundred percent of donations go directly to students. Any citizen or group may donate directly to Kids Cause through United Way.

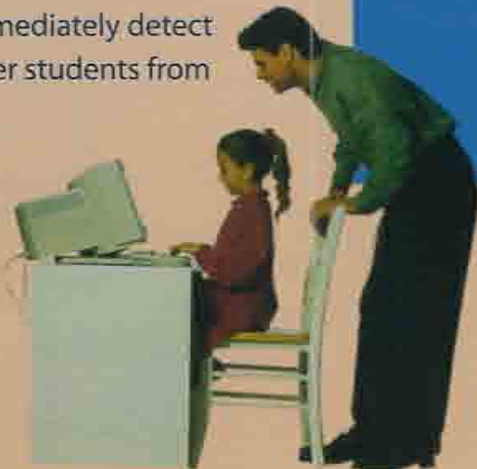
## What is Kids Cause?

Bonneville UniServ educators recognize that many students in our schools are struggling. Some live without the basic necessities of food, clothing and shelter despite the availability of social assistance programs. Alpine, Nebo and Provo Education Associations have joined with United Way and community groups to serve Utah County children. Children from low-income families who need glasses, shoes, winter coats or medical needs, can receive these items through the Kids Cause coordinator at their school.

Over 65 schools in Utah County have selected a Kids Cause coordinator who works with the principal, staff and parents to meet student needs. Teachers have direct contact with their students and can immediately detect physical ailments that deter students from learning.
